The Organ Trinity's magnificent mechanical-action organ is regarded as one of the finest organs in the United Kingdom. The original instrument was built by the famous 'Father' Smith in 1694 and 1706. Over the years many alterations were made, until in 1913 an almost totally new organ was built, on a massive scale.

Organ - history - Trinity College Chapel

The chapel has been changed little since it was built. The stained glass was added in 1885, the gift of the then Bursar, later President, Henry Woods. The organ, and organ loft, were installed in the 1960s. The Chapel of Trinity College Oxford - Martin Kemp (Scala, 2013) provides a more detailed history and can be purchased from the college.

The beautiful classic case and a Trompette en Chamade were added in the 1980's. The Chapel is of the Gothic style and is actually the chancel end of a much larger (imaginary) Cathedral. The organ occupies an area just behind the crossing. There is a regular schedule of recitals by well known organists, and there are several recordings available.

Today, lessons are offered free of charge to Trinity undergraduates on the carillon and on the College's beautiful Austin Organ in the west end, with a substantial 4,416 pipes, which was installed in 1971. The Chapel is among those treasures of Trinity to which all alumni fondly recall and remains a reminder both of the College's Episcopal heritage and its present ecumenical embrace of all faiths.

Trinity College Chapel Organ - Albert Schweitzer Organ ...

The chapel has a fine organ, originally built by "Father" Smith in 1694. Many alterations were made over the years until, in 1913, an almost totally new organ was built. Some of the pipes were so large that they would not fit in the organ loft and instead had to stand in a corner of the ante-chapel.

Holy Trinity Church is blessed to have a 1925 E.M. Skinner organ, one of the finest of its era. The instrument went through a five-year renovation and expansion program between 1995 and 2000. This historic instrument was originally installed in the Coolidge Auditorium of the Library of Congress until it was brought to Holy Trinity in 1955.

Music at the Chapel - Trinity College

The Trinity College Chapel is the gift of the late Gerald Larkin (1885-1961), who headed the Salada Tea Company from 1922 to 1957. He contracted the renowned English architect, Sir Giles Gilbert Scott, who designed the great Gothic cathedral of Liverpool and, famously, the red Post Office telephone kiosks seen throughout England.

Trinity College Chapel - Trinity College

The Great Organ in the Trinity College Chapel was installed in 1954 by the firm of Casavant Frères of Sainte-Hyacinthe, Québec, after a consultation that included the eminent musicians Dr. Healey Willan and Sir Ernest MacMillan. As experts will

recognize, this was before the Organ Reform Movement swept across North America.

Chapel History - Trinity College

The Grant, Degens and Bradbeer organ of New College Chapel was installed in 1969 and proved to be a radical departure from prevailing organ building trends both aurally and visually. Inspired by the brave new instruments being built in North West Europe in the 1960s, this organ wholeheartedly embraced the Orgelbewegung (organ reform movement).

Organ History Trinity College Chapel

The Choir of Trinity College Cambridge comprises around thirty Choral Scholars and two Organ Scholars, all of whom are students at the University. The College's choral tradition dates back to the all-male choir of the fourteenth century, when former Chapel Royal choristers studied in King's Hall which later became part of Trinity College.
